FVTC Health Services

Did you know that if you are a student at FVTC you are eligible to receive services? FVTC Health Services provides: First aid care, Palliative treatment for minor illness and injury so that the individual can return to regular activity, reach home safely, or referred to a physician, Immunizations, Tuberculin skin test, Free over the counter medication for cold, allergy, headache or other pain, upset stomach, diarrhea, cough, and menstrual cramps. Flu shot is coming to FVTC in October please watch for an email from the FVTC Health Services Department for more information. We also offer consultation services to students



who are concerned about a health problem in relation to themselves or their family. Need any assistance with a referral to a physician or other community agency or healthcare provider. FVTC nurse is from Affinity Occupational Health. If you need to make an appointment we encouraged you to call 920-735-5745 to

schedule. We do not offer prescription medication but the nurse can refer you for doctors' care if considered necessary.
